Connections between cosmology and design were central to Jencks' practice as a cultural theorist, landscape designer and architectural historian. In the year that this drawing was made Jencks published The Architecture of the Jumping Universe, a book exploring the impact of complex systems on post-modern architecture and culture. Jencks engaged these ideas in his own designs, including the development of his 30-acre Garden of Cosmic Speculation in Scotland.
