

## WORKSHOP - Making Connections

ARTIST - Hannelore Smith

YEAR GROUP - Key Stage 4 to 5



### DESCRIPTION

During this workshop students can explore how objects in the Sainsbury Centre's collections relate to each other, and how they can be relevant to their own personal study and interests.

Students will gain the confidence and skills to interpret and respond creatively to the exhibits by identifying and working to themes; using questioning and analysis; and will consider how to build on the experience with further research or experimentation.

**SKILLS AND THEMATIC LINKS** Developing creativity, thinking creatively, recording and documenting ideas

**LOCATION** Permanent collection galleries only

**PRICES** *Half day £150* Recommended as one 2 hour session, but could be condensed to two repeated 1 hour sessions. Option to extend to a full day.

**NOTES** Each session accommodates up to 30 students.

Times are typically 10-12:00 and 12:30-14:30pm.

The session will be based on Hannelore's *Making Connections* resource, which is available to download and use before and after the session, as well as during.
