MAKING FLAGS: FUN IN THE SCULPTURE PARK



Materials:

- A 'flag pole' (a straight, strong twig, kebab stick or straw)
- A stapler, cable ties (or string if you don't have cable ties)
- A rectangle of fabric (a bit of an old sheet or pillow case)
- Things to decorate your flag with (wax crayons, sticky backed plastic/foam, stickers or paper and white glue)

How To Make A Flag

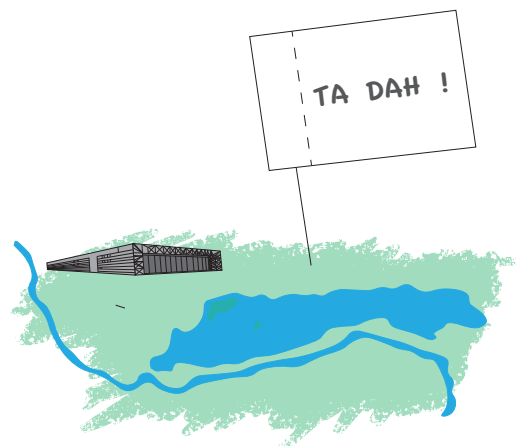
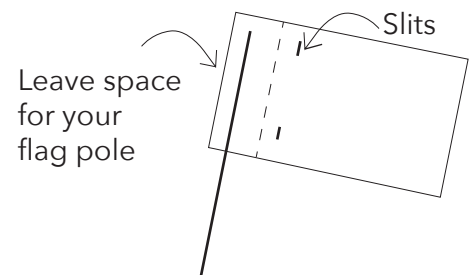
Wrap your fabric around the pole and secure with staples, bulldog clips, cable ties or string.

If you are using cable ties or string, cut two slits and feed either the ties or lengths of string through the slits and around the flag pole then tighten.

You could design a flag to represent yourself or your family, using your favourite colours or animals or pastimes as part of the design.
