DESCRIPTION

Work with Hannelore Smith to explore surface and form by making tactile responses to the objects in our collections.

This workshop celebrates the potential of the most humble of materials - PAPER. It allows students to experiment with making 3D models and samples, and encourages them to capture and record this experience in different ways. They will have the opportunity to transform and translate ideas and outcomes from one technique and process into another.

The workshop will extend the ideas which Hannelore developed within her PAPER resources *Scrunch*, *Pleat*, and *Fold* which are available to download on our website.
