

## WORKSHOP - Distortion

YEAR GROUP - Key Stage 4 to 5



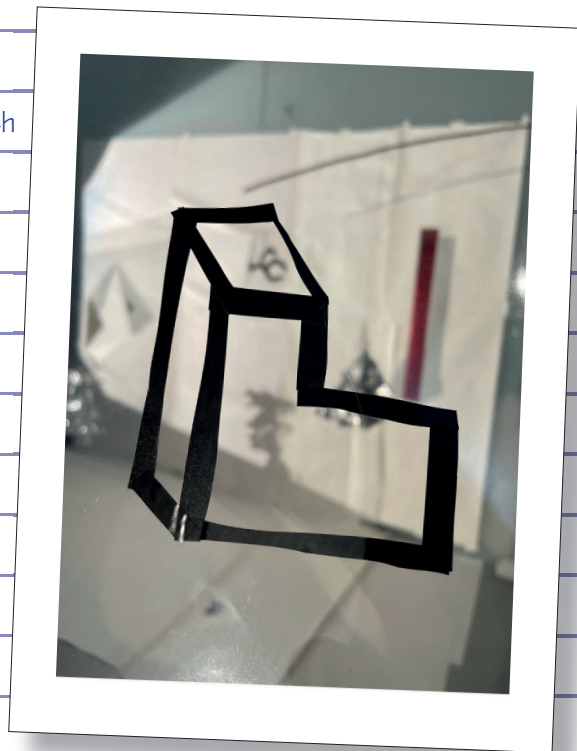
### DESCRIPTION

This workshop provides students with an opportunity to distort and transform photographs which they have taken, outside of the camera, and into a temporary installation in our Studio.

Using a combination of digital projectors and analogue OHPs, students will be able to project images on to a variety of surfaces, planes and objects, and will be encouraged to take further photos of the results.

They will be able to make large geometric sculptures out of folded card and project onto them. They can experiment with hanging mobiles made with a variety of different materials - projecting on to these moving objects, as well as playing with mirrors to 'throw' or layer images.

The installation can be photographed at all of its various stages, or it could be photographed in its entirety as a complete collaborative work.



### SKILLS AND THEMATIC LINKS

**LOCATION** Sainsbury Collection galleries and Studio.

**PRICES £250** Recommended as one 2 hour session, but could be condensed to two repeated 1 hour sessions (each for x15). Option to extend to a full day.
