DESCRIPTION

VISIONS OF ANCIENT EGYPT' SPECIAL

Rose Feather will lead an active, identity-focused exploration of three areas within the Visions of Ancient Egypt exhibition, including drawing, writing and discussions aimed at developing critical thinking skills. Our route through the exhibition will focus on: the many 'visions' of Cleopatra; the provenance of the Ancient Egyptian objects collected by Robert and Lisa Sainsbury; and the contemporary art in the final gallery, with a focus on Egyptian artists.

A following studio workshop will allow students to respond to the exhibition and reflect on the drawing and writing that they made. Rose will demonstrate simple book making, illustration and print-making techniques to support students to develop self-portraits inspired by the exhibition. Students will be invited to think about the multiple ways in which they are perceived and create contrasting representations of themselves to communicate these ideas.



SKILLS AND THEMATIC LINKS

Ancient Egypt; Racial and Cultural Identity; Drawing; Creative Writing; Critical Thinking.

LOCATION *Visions of Ancient Egypt* exhibition and Sainsbury Collection galleries (or Studio)

PRICES £150 (or £250 with Studio). Recommended as one 2 hour session, but could be condensed to two repeated 1 hour sessions (each for x 15). Option to extend to a full day.
Plus admission tickets for 'Visions of Ancient Egypt Exhibition', £3 pp.

NOTES Each 2hr session accommodates up to 30 students.
Sessions are typically 10-12:00 and 12:30-14:30pm.
