This workshop provides an opportunity to study and

question the many 'Benin Bronzes' in the Sainsbury Collection.

We will examine the surface pattern and talk about the

influence of textile practices on these sculptural forms. We will

discuss the problematic provenance of the Bronzes, and how these

 $\operatorname{objects}$ would have been used and displayed in their original home.

Have a go at casting to better understand how the bronzes

were made. Experiment with printing patterns inspired by animals,

and other symbols of power, peace and equality.
