| DESCRIPTION: | Working in small groups, participants will choose an object or image from the collection and transform it into a sculptural costume. At the end of the session these will be worn and processed through the Living Area. |
| | We will start by looking at photos of Stepanova's Constructivist costume designs for 'The Death of Tarelkin', which are part of the Sainsbury Centre's collection. These designs are life-sized wooden cutouts, painted with bold geometric designs. |
| | Participants will be encouraged to embrace a scrappy and explorative approach to making: their task will be to look hard at the objects and invent forms to convey their texture and shape with simple makeshift materials like cardboard, paper and tape. The emphasis will be on improvising and being inventive, not worrying about neatness or finish. |
