DESCRIPTION:	In this workshop Hannelore Smith will introduce students to the Brutalist architecture of the UEA campus and to a selection of works in the Sainsbury Centre collection by Constructivist artists.
	Students will use framing devices to create new compositions from photographs of buildings and sculpture. With these they will build multi-layered prints using gelli-plates - exploring positive and negative shapes; image transfer and mirroring; pattern and texture.
	Students will work experimentally to develop a series of prints, by varying their process and their colour palette and using a range different papers. They will have the option to cut and fold their work to make it 3D.
