YEAR GROUP:	Key Stage 2
DESCRIPTION:	<p>Inspired by indigenous Arctic people's creative resourcefulness, and waste-free ideals, pupils will work collaboratively to construct a sculptural form using found and reclaimed materials.</p> <p>We will support the pupils to combine materials by binding and stitching them together - without glue or tape - so that they develop their craft skills. They will consider the functionality and strength of the joins, as well as how they might beautify the object too.</p> <p>Pupils will also be encouraged to think about our materialistic throw-away culture, and instead to consider the possibility of repairing and reassembling broken or damaged possessions, and the value that this may bring to them.</p>
