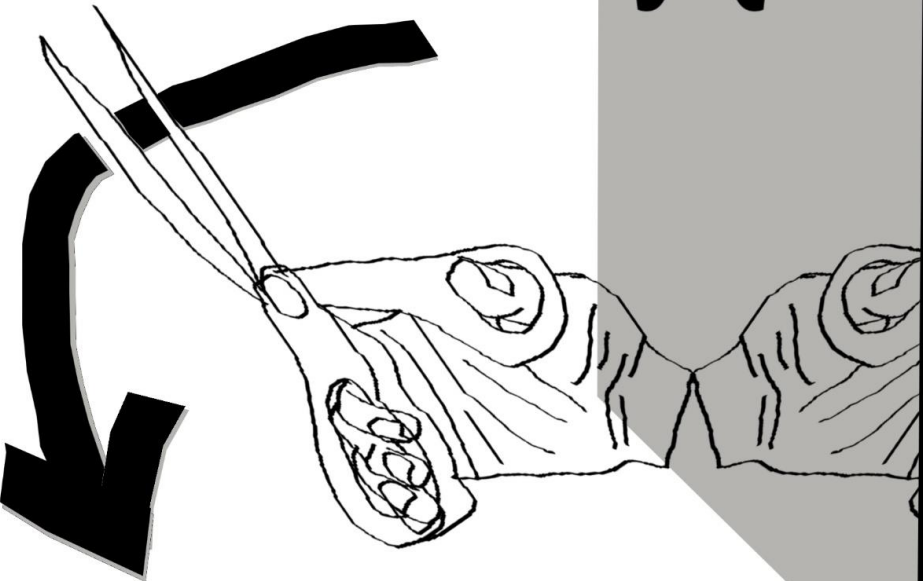


Mirror Play



Start with a mirror, some electrical tape and a pair of scissors. Find an object. Using the tape as line, make a drawing of the object on the surface of the mirror.

Use these mirror-drawings to look at other objects in the collection. Take photos and make drawings.

Tape two mirror-drawings together so they open and close like a book. Experiment with the double reflection.

The Sainsbury Centre has lots of spotlights. See what happens when these lights catch the surface of the mirror-drawing.

Can the tape drawing become sculptural? Can it leave the surface of the mirror?

The tape can be a thick line, a thin line, dots and dashes. You can use it to make a single line drawing or you can use it to cross hatch. It can stretch and turn corners.

Electrical tape is very versatile. It can be used to make drawings that are bold and simple or intricate and detailed.
