

WORKSHOP:	Coiled Baskets

YEAR GROUP:	Key Stage 2
DESCRIPTION:	<p>Make your own miniature coiled basket inspired by the colours and textures in the galleries and surrounding landscape.</p> <p>The Sainsbury Centre is home to many objects that were skillfully made using traditional techniques. Their makers took inspiration and materials from their surroundings to create unique works that tell a story about the place where they were made. In this workshop, we will look at baskets made by indigenous people in North America and find out about the materials and skills used by the maker of an Inupiaq coiled basket from Alaska.</p> <p>We will respond by crafting our own tiny baskets using a simple coiled process, taking our inspiration from materials, colours and textures found in the Living Area or Sculpture Park.</p> <p>During this calm and relaxed workshop, there will be a chance to explore how making can connect us to a place and help us to see it differently.</p>
