DESCRIPTION:	<p>Our everyday lives are full of interesting sounds - indoors and outdoors, in nature and in urban environments. Come and explore the way sounds can influence the way we draw, make marks, and tell our own stories. How do we break those sounds down? How can you recreate a natural sound using household waste, or stuff just lying around?</p> <p>We will encounter the objects in the Sainsbury Centre permanent collection, and work also from our own thoughts and experiences of our world and its objects and today's climate. In small groups we will explore how to transform sketches, thoughts, note-taking and simple impressionistic writing into narrated soundscapes, rich with collected and re-imagined sound and music.</p>
