- Enjoy a drink or light snack at The Terrace Cafe.

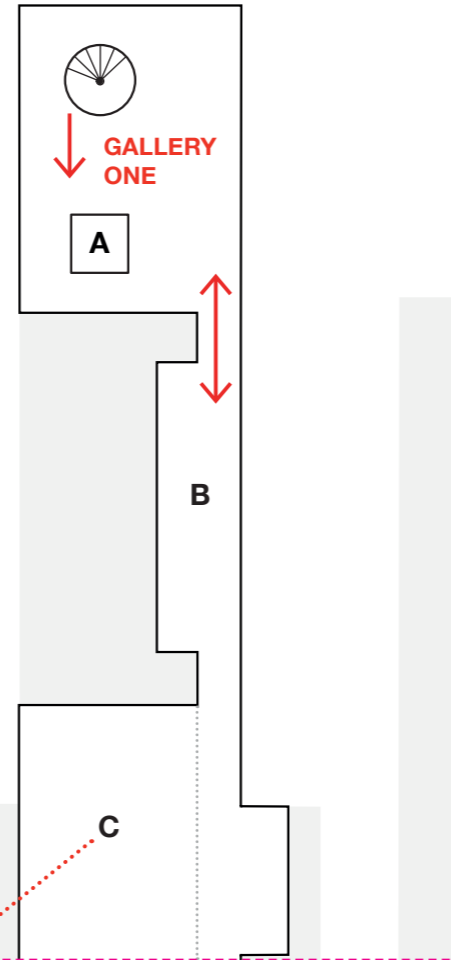
1-2 HOUR VISIT (AFTERNOON)

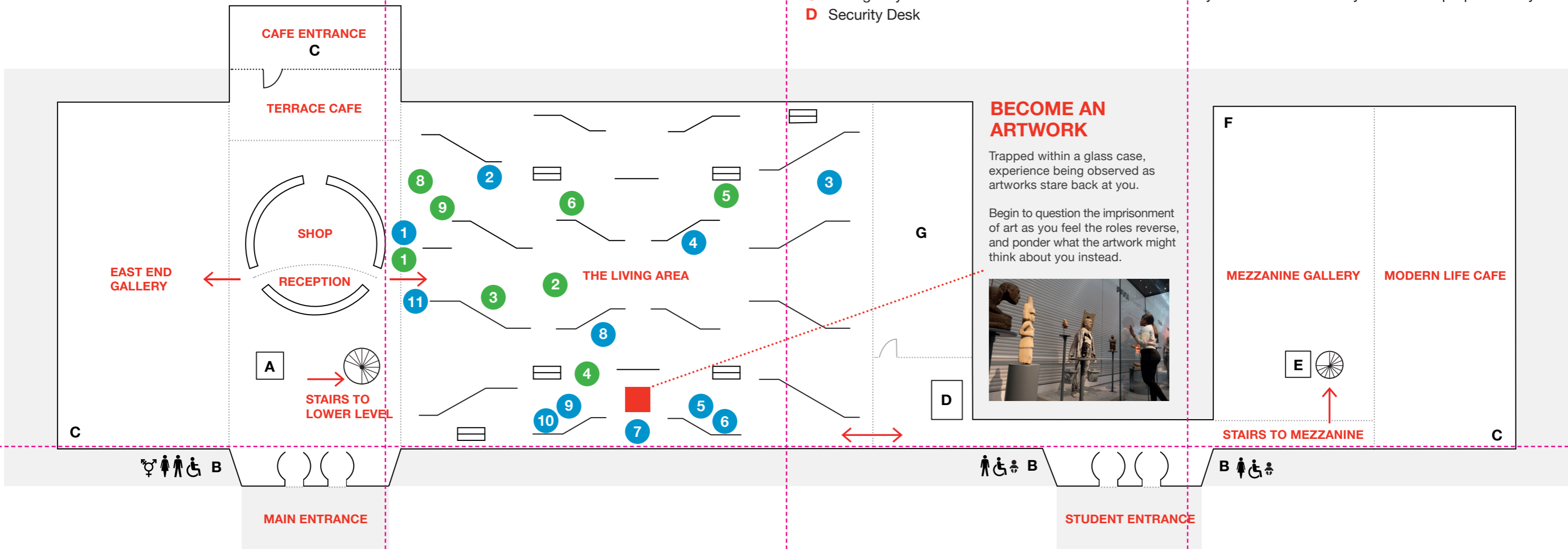

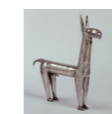

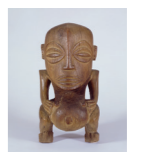
