# Sculpture Park

The Sculpture Park is situated across the University Campus. There are 350 acres of attractive parkland open to everyone to enjoy art, architecture and the natural environment.

Curated by the Sainsbury Centre, works are selected to complement the landscape and listed built environment: from formal gardens adjacent to the Sainsbury Centre to the dense urban modernist architecture and areas of tranguillity along the Yare river valley. As well as great art, there is architecture by leading architects such as Norman Foster, Denys Lasdun and Rick Mather.

The park is also home to our resident population of wild rabbits and habitats for rare and endangered species. There is a wide range of fauna and flora including a number of remarkable ancient oaks. As well as significant works by Henry Moore, Anthony Gormley, Elisabeth Frink, Laurence Edwards, Anthony Caro, Rebecca Warren and Ro Robertson.
